As more than 50% of the votes were cast in favour of each of the Resolutions, all the Resolutions were duly passed as Ordinary Resolutions of the Company.

As at the date of the AGM, the Company had a total number of 3,081,690,283 issued shares, which was the total number of shares entitling holders to attend and vote for or against the Resolutions at the AGM. There was no Shareholder (i) who was entitled to attend the AGM but was required to abstain from voting in favour of any of the Resolutions at the AGM or (ii) who was required to abstain from voting on any of the Resolutions at the AGM.

In the Company's circular dated 21 September 2017, no parties have stated their intention to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the Resolutions at the AGM.

As the proposed final dividend of RMB11.6 cents per share (equivalent to HK13.58986 cents per share at the exchange rate of RMB1: HK\$1.17154 as published by The People's Bank of China on 16 August 2017) and the proposed special final dividend of RMB10 cents per share (equivalent to HK11.71540 cents per share at the exchange rate of RMB1:HK\$1.17154 as published by The People's Bank of China on 16 August 2017) for the financial year ended 30 June 2017 have been approved by the Shareholders at the AGM, the Company would like to remind Shareholders that the register of members of the Company, as announced on 16 August 2017, will be closed for one day on Wednesday, 1 November 2017, to ascertain Shareholders' entitlement to the final dividend and special final dividend.

The Shareholders will be given the option of electing to receive the final dividend and special final dividend in either Renminbi or Hong Kong Dollars or a combination of Renminbi and Hong Kong Dollars. To make the dividend election, the Shareholders should complete the dividend election form (if applicable) and return it to the Hong Kong Share Registrar, not later than 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, 21 November 2017. If no dividend election is made by a Shareholder, such Shareholder will receive the final dividend and special final dividend in Hong Kong Dollars. It is expected that the final dividend and special final dividend will be paid on Monday, 4 December 2017 to Shareholders who are registered at the close of business on Wednesday, 1 November 2017.
